OSDIC STUDENT/YOUNG ADULT TRIP TO ITALY "AN ITALIAN ADVENTURE: A JOURNEY OF DISCOVERY THROUGH HISTORY & CULTURE"

There is an opportunity for students/young adults to travel to Italy to explore the rich history and culture of Italy. The Order Sons & Daughters of Italy of Canada would like to encourage young people to not only become interested in their Italian culture but also become involved as a member of this great organization which celebrates our rich Italian heritage.

- 1. The tentative date for the trip will be May 24, 2024 June 1, 2024.
- 2. There would be 10-14 participants. Students/young adults would be between 18-24.
- 3. The Lodges will use similar criteria to our Scholarship Award. The applicants should be a son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, niece or nephew of a member. The goal would be to have each Lodge to select 2 participants. The respective Lodges may request an essay of what this experience would mean to them.
- 4. The Italian Government will subsidize the 7-day cultural and educational trip to Italy. The subsidy would cover hotel accommodations (usually 2 per room,) entrance to major sites such as the Colosseum, the Vatican and Museums, and guides who speak both Italian and English. The trip would include all breakfasts and dinners.

HOUSING CORPORATION - CALL FOR BOARD NOMINATIONS



The Housing Corporation operates five subsidized housing projects to meet the needs of families, seniors, and persons with disabilities. These projects include 349 apartments and 146 family homes and townhouses. Working with agencies such as the March of Dimes and the Visiting Homemakers Association, the Housing Corporation has introduced innovative supportive housing programs for a variety of groups over the years.

Skills Needed: To ensure the continued success of our projects and the seamless transition to our new facility and club location, we are specifically looking for individuals skilled in areas such as facility management, project relocation, financial planning, and community development.

Commitment: Board members are expected to actively participate by attending 5-6 meetings annually, typically scheduled every other month. The board generally does not convene during the summer months unless there are exceptional circumstances or urgent matters that require attention.

NEW FACILITY UPDATE

I am excited to share with the membership an update regarding the Hamilton Italian Centre (HIC) project that we announced back in April 2023.

This project has been initiated through the support of the Order Sons and Daughters of Italy Hamilton Community Group of organizations, which consists of the SDI Hamilton Trieste Lodge, SDI Hamilton Housing Corporation, and the SDI Hamilton Charitable Corporation at Villa Italia.

The Hamilton Italian Centre (HIC) will be led by a new corporation known as the Sons and Daughters of Italy Hamilton Community Corporation. To start, the new corporation's board consists of equal representation from each of the three existing boards and will be supported by 6 committees involving 30+ community volunteers.

We take possession of the 420 Crerar Drive property (currently known as Guido De Bres High School) on Friday January 5th, 2024.

Over the course of 2024 -2026 we will be developing and rolling out programming for a multi-generational gathering space. The Centre's purpose will include promoting Italian Canadian culture, celebrating Hamilton Italian history, and offering space to community partners focused in the areas of business networking, health, and family services, as well as social, educational, and athletic programing.

The Centre will also become the new home for the Sons and Daughters of Italy Hamilton Trieste Lodge and will include a café/osteria and banquet facilities. The Hamilton Italian Centre will be open to the broader community interested in partnerships and/or for hosting their own meetings and events.

Through the newsletter, and the lodge's monthly meetings, we look forward to continuing to provide ongoing updates to the membership, and the broader community, on our progress. Furthermore, we are building out a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) page on our website which will act as a resource and to address your questions.

We value creating a space inclusive of all ages, backgrounds, and community organizations. Italians have a saying, "Tutti a tavola", meaning "everyone at the table" – our hope is that this philosophy extends to the Centre's visitors and community partners.

On behalf of the board, a huge thank you all to the board and community volunteers who have stepped up over the past nine months. We have a lot of heavy lifting to do over the next few years. However, I am confident that the team assembled will make the Hamilton Italian Centre a premier facility serving our community and one that exemplifies the long-standing values of the Order Sons and Daughter of Italy of Hamilton.




